Figure 1: A comparison of the alternative names for MAMs by SLTs and Staff

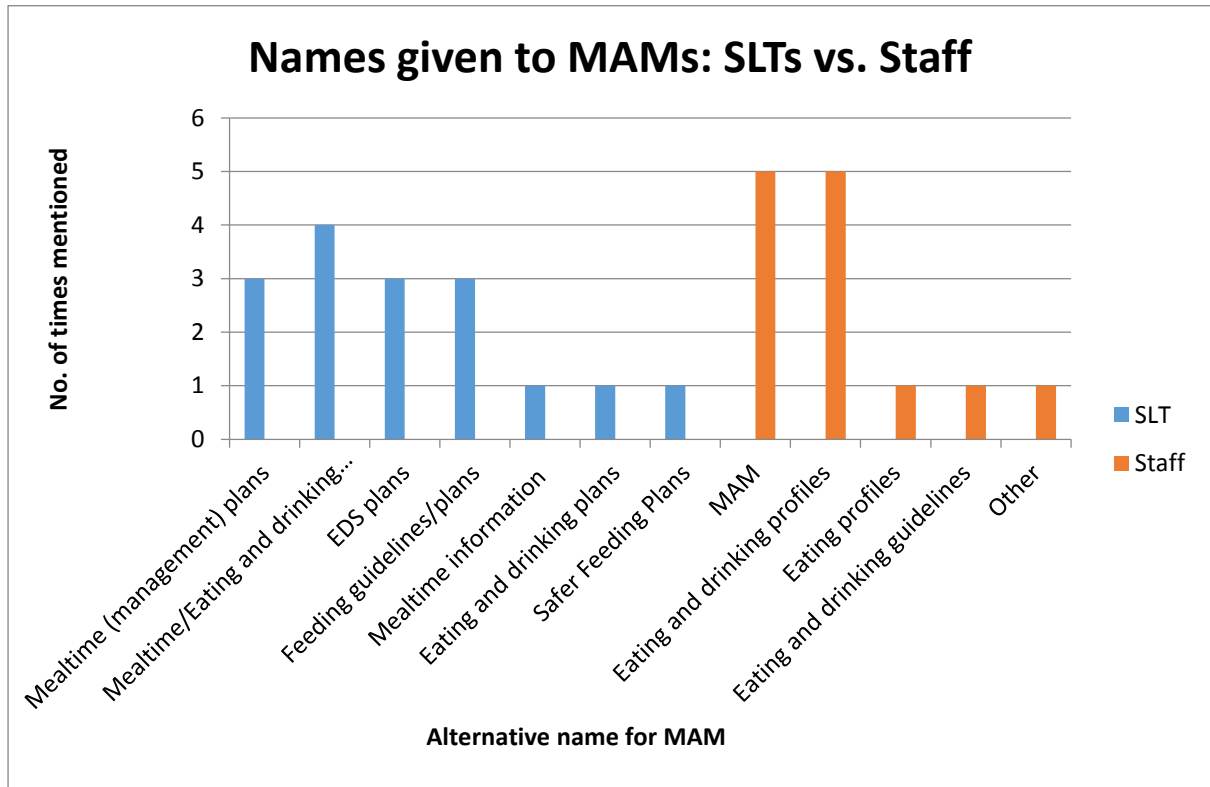


Figure 2: The information included on a MAM – a comparison between staff and SLT responses

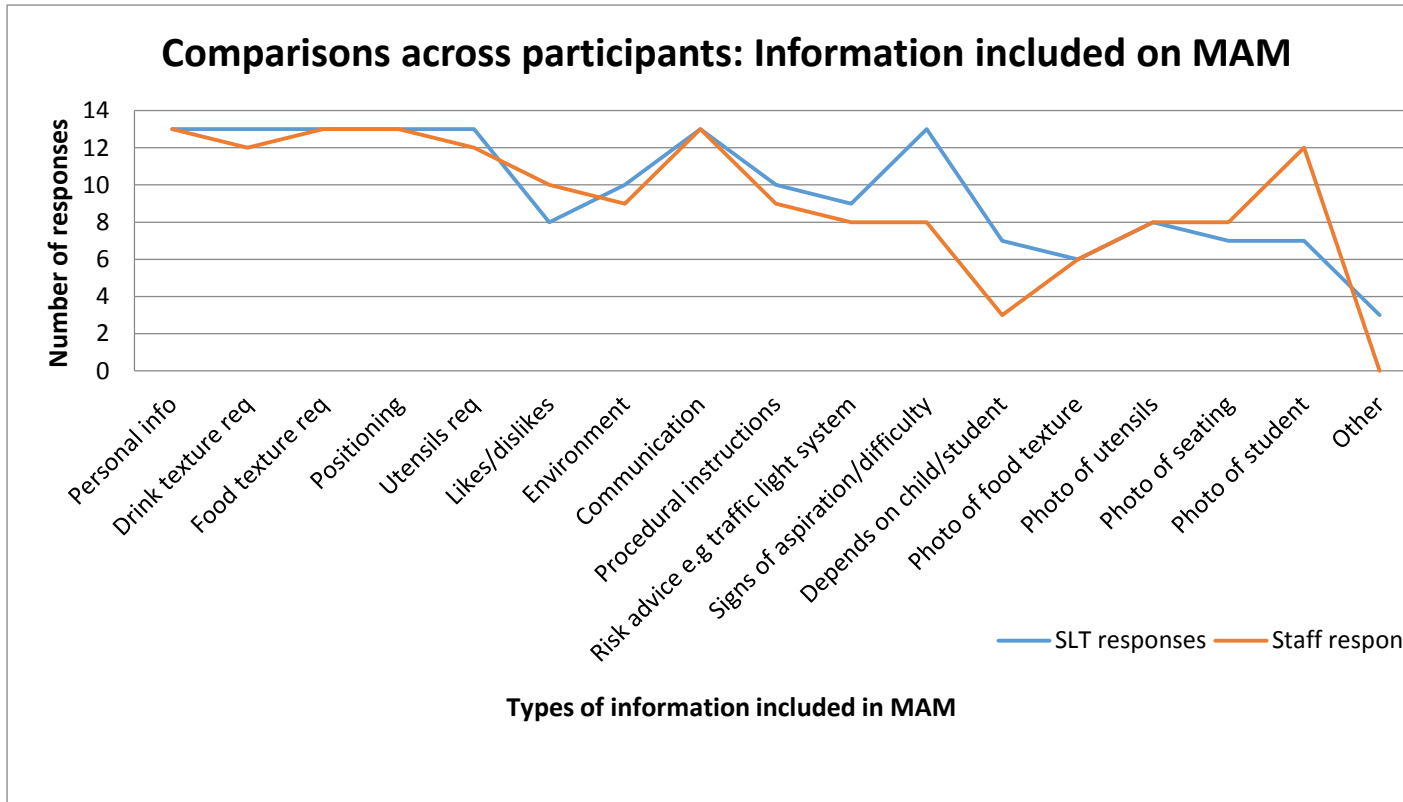


Figure 3: Comparisons of where staff and SLT keep MAMs
